Request for Information Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: What counties are included in the Thousand Oaks-Oxnard-Ventura Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA)?

A1: Ventura County is the only county that is included in the Thousand Oaks-Oxnard-Ventura MSA.

Q2: At what level of specificity do you want the Priority Climate Action Plan (PCAP) GHG inventory?

A2: We would prefer to have the GHG inventory for the PCAP be at the city/unincorporated level, but understand that the timeline may limit the ability to gather the data necessary to complete it at this level by the deadline. A GHG inventory at the county level is acceptable for the PCAP.

Q3: Could you elaborate on the request for "identification and description of the climate impacts or risks to LIDACs?" Is the county interested in a climate risk and vulnerability assessment, or is the requirement limited to the items described in the <u>EPA Guidance document</u> for LIDAC Benefits Analysis?

A3: Because the deadline for the PCAP is fast approaching, the expectation for this requirement is to fulfill the items described in the <u>EPA Guidance document for LIDAC Benefits Analysis</u>. However, the county is interested in including a climate risk and vulnerability assessment for future deliverables. If a consultant feels confident in their ability to deliver this item within the parameters of the RFI, they are welcome to include it in their proposal.
