

Ventura County Domain Transition Notice

The County of Ventura is working to transition our main website domain from <u>www.ventura.org</u> to <u>www.VenturaCounty.gov</u>. While this will take several months to complete, we are starting the conversion with some of our smaller sites such as this one.

Why the Change?

In accordance with the **California Assembly Bill 1637 mandate** and to enhance security and accessibility, Ventura County is transitioning websites from the current domain, <u>www.Ventura.org</u>, to the new domain, <u>www.VenturaCounty.gov</u>. This move is part of a broader initiative to standardize government domains under the .gov extension, which is reserved for government organizations and provides additional security and trust to the public.

What Does This Mean for You?

- **Improved Security:** The .gov domain ensures that you are connecting to an official and secure government website, providing confidence in your interactions with county services.
- Enhanced Access: A .gov domain helps reduce confusion, making it easier for residents and visitors to find and access official county information.
